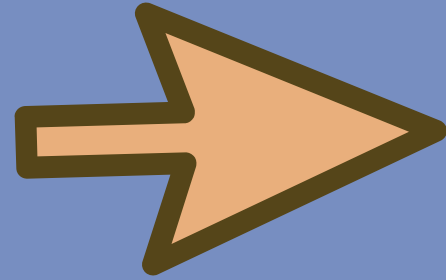
Ubi puer Arcas nymphae nātus est*, Iūnō dīxit, "Causa

drop the -ī

dō, dāre, **dedī**, datum -> **ded**

videō, vidēre, **vidī**, vīsum -> **vid**

Perfect of compounds of Sum

ab + sum, esse, fuī, futūrum= be away/absent

āfuī	I have been away, I was absent
āfuistī	you have been away, you were absent
āfuit	he, she, it has been away, was absent
āfuimus	we have been away, were absent
āfuistis	you (pl.) have been away, were absent
āfuērunt	they have been away, were absent
